December Cross Country Activities



Thursday, December 19th Cross Country Ski Lesson

Howard Kantor will lead a cross-country (classic or skate) outing at Soldier Hollow in Midway.

Meet by 9 A.M. to carpool from Wasatch Bagels on Snow Creek Drive, or by 9:30 A.M., in order to rent equipment, at Soldier hollow, 2002 Soldier Hollow Dr. Midway 435-654-2002 at 10. Howard has arranged for a 2-hour instruction from 10 A.M. to noon.

Cost is \$15 for 2 hours of equipment and a trail pass, or just the trail pass alone without equipment, no lesson included. (Normal trail pass is \$18, so we are getting rental free) Cost for above WITH lesson is \$45.

Soldier Hollow has groomed cross-country ski trails, marked from green to black. Due to the hills, ski skating may be preferred for moderate or advanced. Those who don't take a lesson can break into small groups depending on ski levels. People can also snow shoe.

Mahalo nui loa (thank you very much) from the bottom of my heart, to Karen and all club members!

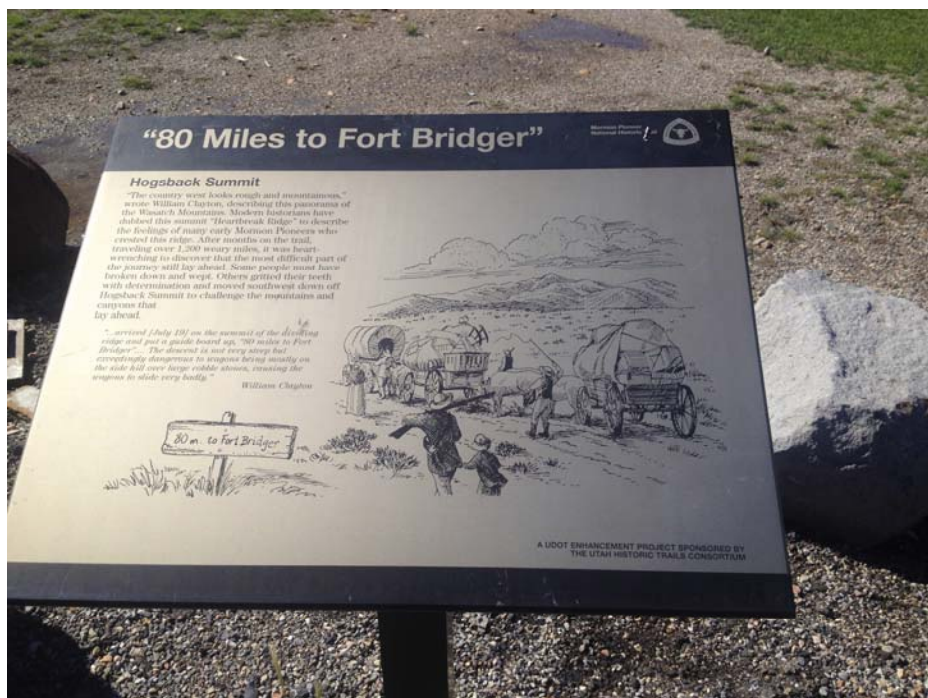

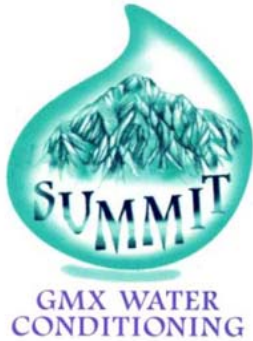

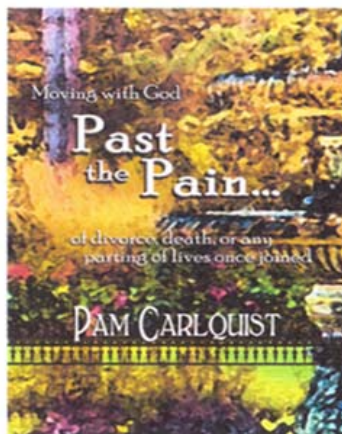
